Best Sustainable Investment Policy

The overall philosophy set out in BNP Paribas Asset Management (BNPP AM) sustainability strategy revolves around energy transition, healthy ecosystems and greater equality in society – their so-called three Es. Taken together, these form a pathway to economic sustainability that BNPP AM believes will enable investors to safeguard long-term returns. In the past few years, BNPP AM has published specific roadmaps on various aspects of this strategy, which also serves as a way of enhancing accountability in its sustainability commitments.

Stewardship (voting, engagement and policy advocacy) forms an essential part of BNPP AM sustainability strategy. They believe that meaningful engagement with issuers and policymakers enhances their investment processes by helping to manage long-term risk for their clients by promoting strong ESG practices. Corporate engagement—together with voting and policy advocacy, are key to BNPP AM's stewardship strategy. Led by Jane Ho, BNPP AM's Head of Stewardship APAC based in Singapore, they engaged with 72 issuers in the Asia-Pacific (APAC) region in 2025.

BNPP AM also actively collaborates with policymakers in the region. For example, BNPP AM is part of the Joint Committee on Climate Change (JC3), a regulator-industry collaborative initiative focusing on climate resilience in Malaysia. Angelia Chin-Sharpe, CEO of BNPP AM Singapore and Head of Distribution Southeast Asia, is the company's representative for JC3. Additionally, BNPP AM's global head of sustainability, Jane Ambachtsheer, has been a member of the Monetary Authority of Singapore's sustainable finance advisory panel (SFAP) since its inception.

BNPP AM also supports their clients through thought leadership, distilling complex topics—such as ESG regulation, sustainability trends, or market risks—into structured insights for our clients.

BNPP AM's strong focus on ESG globally has fed through to local markets in Asia such as Indonesia, where the company has had operations for more than 30 years.

A defining characteristic of BNPP AM Indonesia's approach is its ability to deliver end-to-end investment solutions. Rather than offering stand-alone products, the firm works closely with institutional clients to design comprehensive investment frameworks—from strategic asset allocation and portfolio construction to implementation and ongoing portfolio monitoring.

BNPP AM was the first fund manager in Indonesia to launch a mutual fund that invests fully in offshore markets as a US dollar-denominated investment solution. It was also the first to offer a China-focused fund and the first to offer a global technology theme.
